Prevent costly denials of service

Use centralized alert monitoring and “held license” notifications to spot stranded licenses and server issues before denied requests block engineers and stall projects.

Reliable data ingestion (RL parser)

Enhanced heartbeat monitoring, observability and stability in the RL parser reduce ingestion gaps and speed up root-cause analysis.



Security hardening

Remediation of SSRF vulnerabilities, improved error handling and agent CVE fixes to strengthen platform posture and reduce audit risk.



Chargeback and cost allocation

Analyze usage across business units, locations, projects and contracts to charge back consumption and expose shelfware.
